Abstract:

Acquire 108.5 acres of land adjacent to the 555 acre Janet Johnson WMA. The land is a mix of forest (29 acres), wetlands (35 acres on the NWI), and agriculture (44.5 acres). This land will be seeded with native vegetation and managed as part of the Janet Johnson WMA

Program Narrative

Design and Scope of Work:

This parcel has recently been inherited by the siblings whose parents died last year. The siblings are interested in selling the parcel as soon as possible and they would prefer to see the land as part of the Janet Johnson WMA, however they will sell the parcel for development if this application is not successful. The land is close to the City of North Branch. The land has access off of Chisago County 14, a black topped road. The land will provide good public access from the north through this parcel to the Janet Johnson WMA. The parcel has great diversity and will provide excellent pheasant, turkey, deer habitat and be an excellent addition to the existing WMA. There are three other smaller parcels that in the future would round out the acquisition of the WMA. This acquisition will also provide an open space corridor linking the Janet Johnson WMA with the North Branch of the Sunrise River. The Chisago Pheasants Forever Chapter, the Long Spurs of the Sunrise NWTF Chapter and the DNR Area Wildlife Manager are supporters and partners in the project. The continued enhancement of the Janet Johnson WMA has been a community supported effort and there has not been any opposition to the acquisition. The local conservation organizations, the local fire department and local government staff will be involved in the development of the area once acquired.

Planning:

This acquisition is consistent with the Council's vision for the Metropolitan Urbanizing Section. The land is highly developable and if sold for development would significantly detract from the value and utilization of the Janet Johnson WMA. The land contains a number of wetlands, forested areas and agricultural lands. The agricultural lands will be planted to native prairie upon acquisition giving perpetual protection to this biologically diverse landscape. There will be excellent public access through this site to the existing WMA. In an urbanizing area good access that also provides great hunting for pheasants, turkey and deer is hard to come by. The acquisition will further <u>the "Priority Actions for the Metropolitan Urbanizing Area: 1) Protect, enhance and restore native prairie (restore native prairie); 2) Provide habitat corridors (corridor connection to the North Branch Sunrise River which is tributary to the St. Croix River).</u>

Relationship to Other Constitutional Funds

There is no direct relationship to other Constitutional Funds

Relationship to Current Organizational Budget

Chisago County does not have other funds that could be used for this acquisition. This is a one time opportunity and does not substitute for traditional funding sources.

Sustainability and Maintenance

The County, SWCD, Chisago PF, Long Spurs of the Sunrise, local deer hunters, local fire department and other volunteers will provide the necessary development for the site (boundary signing, parking area, native prairie seeding, old building demolition, etc. The land will be turned over to the DNR to manage as part of the Janet Johnson WMA. The local interests listed above will also provide assistance in the long-term maintenance of the area by participating in noxious weed management and periodic burning of the site to enhance native vegetation.
