Abstract

Funding for the commissioner of natural resources to perform or contract for pre-transaction services relating to land acquisition proposals submitted to the Lessard-Sams Outdoor Heritage Council upon the Council's request, including, but not limited to, appraisals, surveys or title research.

Activity Detail

Design and Scope of Work

This project would provide a source of funding for the commissioner of natural resources to perform or contract for pre-transaction services upon request by the Lessard-Sams Outdoor Heritage Council. Services would relate to high-priority individual land acquisition proposals submitted to the Council. These could be

either DNR proposals or proposals submitted by other entities. Project funds would not be expended unless specifically requested by the Council.

Project funds would be for the purpose of providing information that would aid the Council in its evaluation of pending land acquisition proposals or provide the Council with information needed before money is appropriated from Outdoor Heritage Fund for acquisition of the lands. For example, if the Council determined that it needed independent appraisal information to evaluate the merits of a land acquisition proposal or to recommend the appropriate amount of funding for the acquisition, it could ask the commissioner to cause the lands to be appraised. The commissioner, acting as agent for the Council, would then use project funds to contract with a qualified independent appraiser to conduct an appraisal to determine the market value of the lands. The commissioner would also use project funds to contract for a technical or administrative review of the appraisal. DNR contract administration costs and other expenses associated with performance of work at the Council's request would also be covered by project funds. Other examples of pre-transaction services that could be performed with project funds upon the Council's request are surveys, reviews of legal descriptions or title research.

Legislative authorization of this proposal may need to address the classification of the appraisal as under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minn. Stat. sec. 13.44, as the intent of the proposal is to authorize disclosure of appraisal data to the Council/public before there is an agreement for the purchase and sale of the property. Legislative authorization may also need to address the applicability of procedures set forth in Minn. Stat. sec. 84.0272.

Direct and necessary costs of the DNR for this project will be determined based on Council requests and the type of work to be performed.
