Attached is the thumbnail report that shows the acres accomplished and dollars spent-to-date whether from the final reports or from the most recent status updates.

The major limitation of this report is that the data doesn't tell the entire story of a programs accomplishments. It is easy to make assumptions on progress-to-date or progress completed by just looking at the numbers. Below are a few examples where numbers don't tell the entire story.

- Double counting of acres being R/E and acquired in the first couple of years until reporting was clarified some did amendments to correct some were noted in the final reports
- An amendment to the acres was approved by the Council in the past, newer members were not part of that decision or may not remember the presentation (ML 2013 and ML 2012 Grouse – Gun Lake acquisition – June 2013)
- Parcel availability changed during the program therefore changing acres however the program is still accomplishing what the intent was
- The acres reported in the AP only reflect a portion of the actual impact; other funds were used to fully fund additional acres nearby creating a larger complex that was reflective in the original acres (ML 2010 Washington County)
- A single land deal where a large acreage match was anticipated, fell through. The project Manager pursued other parcels with like intent, but don't have the large acre match

When final reports are submitted, the program file is pulled and read in its entirety to see if amendments approved in the past had an effect on dollars spent and acres accomplished. In all cases to date, there is a clear explanation if major discrepancies were applicable. In a case where there would not be an explanation, the manager would be asked to present to the Council explaining what happened during the appropriation period and why an amendment was not requested.

So as to not inappropriately jeopardize future funding recommendations of a program, please contact me with any questions you may have on figures that are of concern to you. A quick discussion and with the ability to review the file will can help provide assurance and explanation.
