(03:50:00) Discussion: Allocation Process Guidelines

Executive Director Mark Johnson provided an overview of the allocation process guidelines and briefly discussed the preliminary allocation target for ML 2018/ FY 2019. Council members discussed the allocation process. Motion by Ms. Kingston to adopt the allocation process guidelines. **Motion adopted.**

Mr. Johnson provided a more thorough explanation of the preliminary allocation target for ML 2018/ FY 2019. The allocation recommendation will ultimately be based on the "most recent" (February 2018) forecast and the statutorily mandated 5% reserve. Considering that \$1,958,000 of FY19 funds were appropriated in FY18 legislation, following are 10%, 7%, and 5% reserve scenarios:

- 10% reserve minus \$1,958,000 leaves an approximate allocation target of \$103.9 million.
- 7% reserve minus \$1,958,000 leaves an approximate allocation target of \$107.2 million.
- 5% reserve minus \$1,958,000 leaves an approximate allocation target of \$109.4 million.

Staff recommended Council consider a 7% reserve to accommodate any possible downward forecast fluctuation. Council members discussed.

Motion by Mr. Hartwell to increase the allocation target to \$108 million, leaving roughly a 6% reserve. Council members discussed the motion.

Motion by Rep. Fabian to amend Mr. Hartwell's motion and go with the 7% reserve as recommended by staff. Chair Anderson called division on the vote. **Motion adopted (7 – yes, 5 – no).**

Chair placed the question of the motion as amended to set the allocation target at \$107.2 million leaving at 7% reserve. **Motion adopted.**
