Suggested Motion:

Move to approve all of the accomplishment plans for the ML 2018 appropriations as provided in the DRAFT LSOHC member binders sent to members in November 2017.

Council members may remove plans for further discussion and/or approval at an upcoming meeting.

Background:

MS 97A.056, Subd. 12 requires recipients of Outdoor Heritage Funds to submit accomplishment plans to the Lessard-Sams Outdoor Heritage Council in the form prescribed by the council for council approval. Those accomplishment plans are the deliverables tied to expenditure of the appropriation. Programs whose accomplishment plans conform to the submitted proposal and appropriation language are placed on the consent list.

In order to enable managers to start spending July 1, 2018, the council must approve the APs at the June 28th council meeting.

Staff contacted all program managers and asked if there were any changes of significance that would require re-writing or updating of the DRAFT Accomplishment plans that were submitted for Council review in October 2017. There were three programs with significant changes:

- <u>5(o) / HRE 08 Two Rivers Fish Passage Restoration and Habitat Enhancement</u>. The AP was revised to reflect the December Council action to add \$300,000 to original recommendation of \$1,700,000 to total \$2.0 million.
- <u>5(i) / HRE 02 Lower Mississippi Rier Habitat Partnership</u>. The AP was revised to reflect the December Council action to fully fund this at \$1,555,000.
- <u>5(m) / HREO6 Lake George Dam and Rum River Erosion</u>. Per the Council request, the AP was revised to include fish passage activity. The Accomplishment Plans are attached for Council review.

All managers receiving money in ML 2018 appropriation are up to date with status updates. Final Reports for ML 2013 are due November 1, 2018. Staff will report back at the November 15th meeting with another update.

The Final Accomplishment Plans posted to the web will include the full legal citation and appropriation language as passed in the ML 2018 bill.
