"Call For Funding Requests" Timeline

December or January	Council approves for publication LSOHC's annual "Call for Funding Requests"
April 1st	"Call" is posted & published
End of May	"Call" is closed.
June	LSOHC staff compiles and reviews applications for Council.
 End of June	Council receives Proposal Binders & begins review process.
July – August	Council reviews & scores proposals based on 10 criteria approved by Council. Council discusses scorings of individual members and of Council in aggregate.
Aug/Sept/Oct/Nov	Hold hearings to receive Project Manager testimony (Aug or Sept), continue vetting process by seeking additional information, Council deliberates proposal rankings/merit/need/appropriate funding, etc.
December	Council adopts finalized Funding Recommendations, approves language for Bill & approves staff to submit recommendations to Legislative Leadership by January 15 th .
January	Approved OHF Funding Recommendations (in bill form) are submitted to Legislative leadership by January 15 (per 97A.056, subd 3(a)).

Call Prep, Posting, & Dissemination

- Activities performed each year:
 - Review & expand LSOHC ListServe & Media Database
 - News Outlets (printed, radio, tv, on-line, cultural media outlets)
 - Engage an external Media Posting Service
 - All traditional media venues in MN & border areas (papers, radio, tv)
 - Online Media & Social Media venues
 - April 1 Posting of Call
 - Web
 - LSOHC Media lists
 - Media Posting Service
 - Social Media
 - Request our conservation colleagues to share in whatever avenue they are willing and able to do so.
 - Agencies, NGOs, etc.

Call related outreach

Upon posting of call

- Email message & copy of Call sent to
 - <u>ALL</u> MN Senators & Representatives & their LAs
 - Some replies of thanks, some leads, some requests for presentations
 - All MN Tribal Entities
 - Followed up with phone calls to all in 2021, many in 2022.
 - Followed up with emails to select contacts
 - All Counties, Townships, Cities, other local govt. units
 - MASWD, MAWD, League of MN Cities, etc.
 - Follow up emails or phone calls to County Land Managers, etc
- With each contact, we offer help from LSOHC staff
 - To contact potential recipient
 - Provide presentations
 - Meet personally, zoom, phone

Outreach via hearings

- Legislative Hearings (early in session)
 - At each House/Senate hearing opportunity, LSOHC staff remind legislators of email/call
 - Request legislators to contact us with any constituent leads
 - Remind legislators of LSOHC staff availability for
 - Questions
 - Presentations
 - Materials

Media Outreach

Media Outreach

- Around the time the Call is posted
 - Contact various media via phone or email
 - Alert them of Call & opportunity for proposals
 - Ask that they consider a story or announcement
 - Provide info of OHF projects/success stories
 - Provide contacts for
 - interviews
 - Council members
 - Project managers
 - Legacy Committee Chairs
 - CPL, etc.

In-Person Outreach

Also do personalized outreach

- Seek opportunities to provide presentations
 - Prior to Covid provided presentations
 - In Legis. Districts at Request of Reps/Sen.
 - To Conservation & Environmental groups
 - To Associations (MAWD, MASWD, etc)
 - Groups No. County Land Use Board, MN FRC, etc.
 - During Covid no in-person presentations. Some via zoom/phone.
 - 2022 beginning again with in-person meetings/presentations
 - Presentation MAWD (3/16)
 - Project Proposal Discussions Great River Passage Conservancy, Voyageurs Nat'l Park Staff, Upper Sioux Community, CLFL Watershed Dist. (twice), Great River Greening, TPL, & more.

Over-all Objectives/Goals

LSOHC Staff Objectives:

- Alert public to OHF funding opportunity
- Help potential applicants be successful
 - Defining & focusing habitat ideas/projects/proposals
 - Find appropriate funding (OHF, CPL, ENRTF, CW, Parks, etc)
 - Spark ideas that may lead to future proposals
 - Fiscal capacity (some need help finding fiscal partners)

LSOHC Goals:

- Facilitate an open & inclusive OHF funding process.
- Facilitate habitat proposals for Council consideration
