Amendment Change Summary:

Pheasants Forever would like to purchase the parcel, identified on the parcel list as Kinzer Creek – Stearns County (\$4,200,000 / 298 acres), to be conveyed to Stearns County near the City of Cold Spring. County ownership is an addition to the current accomplishment plan.

- Page 7 added County/Municipal to where activity takes place & variations updated for hunting/fishing
- Page 8 Update ownership and designation of acquired parcel & update info on trails
- Budget shifts:

Considerations for the acquisition:

- Stearns Co. wants to utilize 6 acres as a boat landing, parking lot, restrooms, fishing pier, primitive camping, and picnic shelter. LSOHC funds will not be used to install these items.
- The entire property, 253.4 acres, has already been appraised and surveyed. If the above mentioned 6 acres are not approved by LSOHC we would need to split the acquisition into multiple tracts which would require ordering new appraisals, surveys and essentially starting the project over.
- All other acres will be managed by Stearns Co. as habitat for wildlife similar to how WMA's and WPA's are managed.
- Upland and wetland acres will be restored by Pheasants Forever using LSOHC funds.
- Limited hunting and trapping restrictions, such as firearm hunting limited to fine shot only, or trapping by permit only.
- Minimal grass trails may be mowed on the property for use by hunters, hikers, birders etc.
