

HA01: St. Croix Watershed Habitat Protection and Restoration Phase 5

PROTECTION THROUGH CONSERVATION EASEMENT

Minnesota Land Trust's 1,729-acre working forest conservation easement project on the Willow River in Pine County is well advanced and will be closing in the upcoming months.

The property includes 11.1 miles of shoreline on the Willow River, several intermittent streams, and many small ponds. The red oak and northern hardwood forests, immature aspen stands, lowland confer forests, lowland brush (bog), and the streams and ponds provide habitat for a wide variety of fish and wildlife including a significant number of Minnesota's Species in Greatest Conservation Need, such as gray wolf, red-shouldered hawk, veery, sedge wren, least flycatcher, swamp sparrow, ovenbird, and golden-winged warbler, among others.


PROTECTION THROUGH FEE-TITLE ACQUISITION



In April 2023 Trust for Public Land (TPL) conveyed 241 acres of forested land in Chisago County to the MN DNR as an addition to the Chengwatana State Forest. This expansive property borders National Park Service land along the full length of its nearly mile-long eastern boundary and is just a short distance from the federally designated Wild and Scenic St. Croix River.

Located a half mile south is the Chengwatana I property, a 729-acre addition to the Chengwatana State Forest which TPL previously acquired with its ML19 appropriation. This property was the largest remaining natural, undeveloped, and privately held land block left between Chengwatana State Forest and Wild River State Park.

The permanent protection helps to link those two areas to solidify a protected corridor for wildlife, as well as provide outstanding public recreational opportunities for hunting, hiking, and nature observation.
