

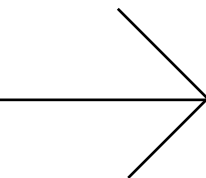

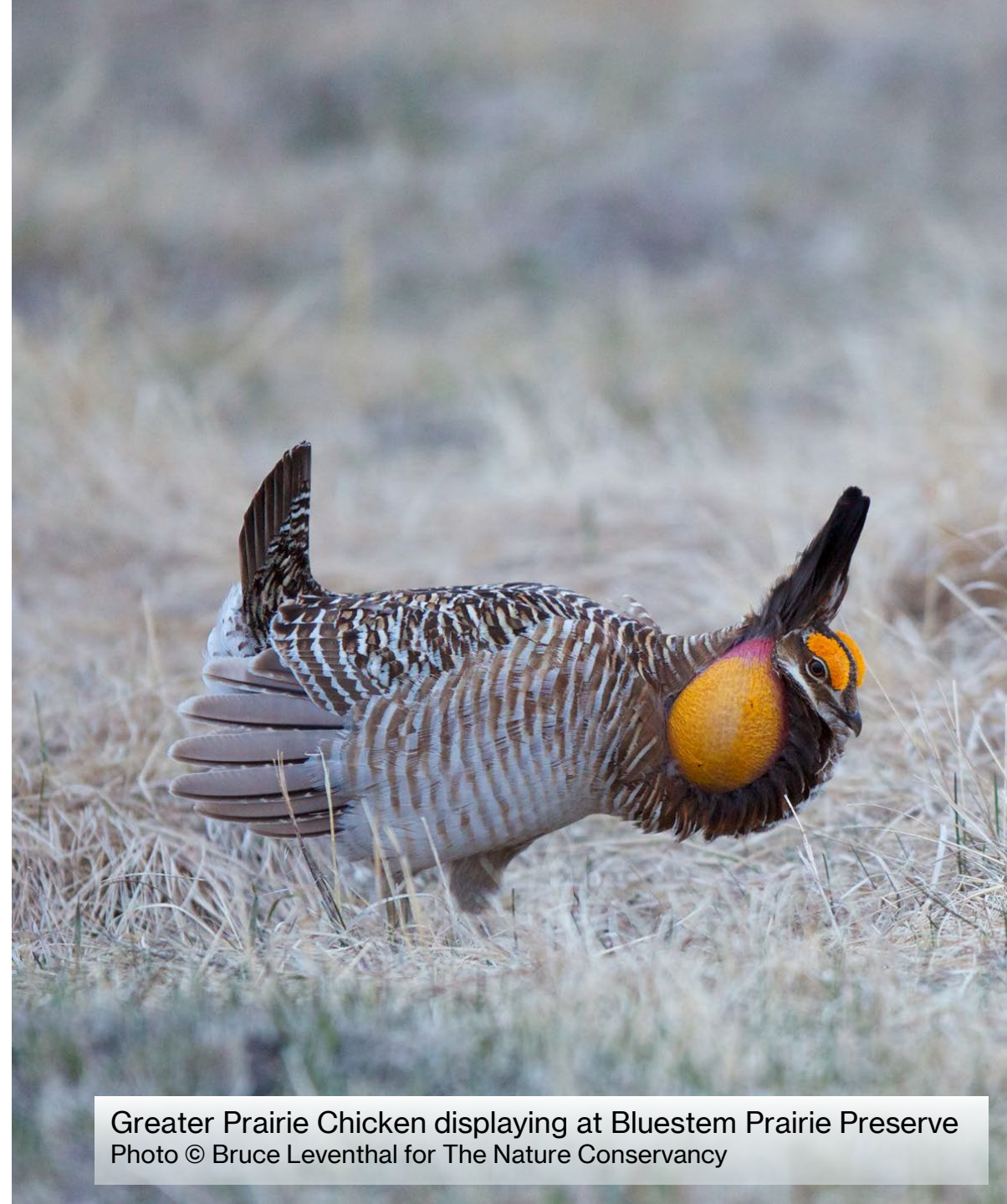


Background

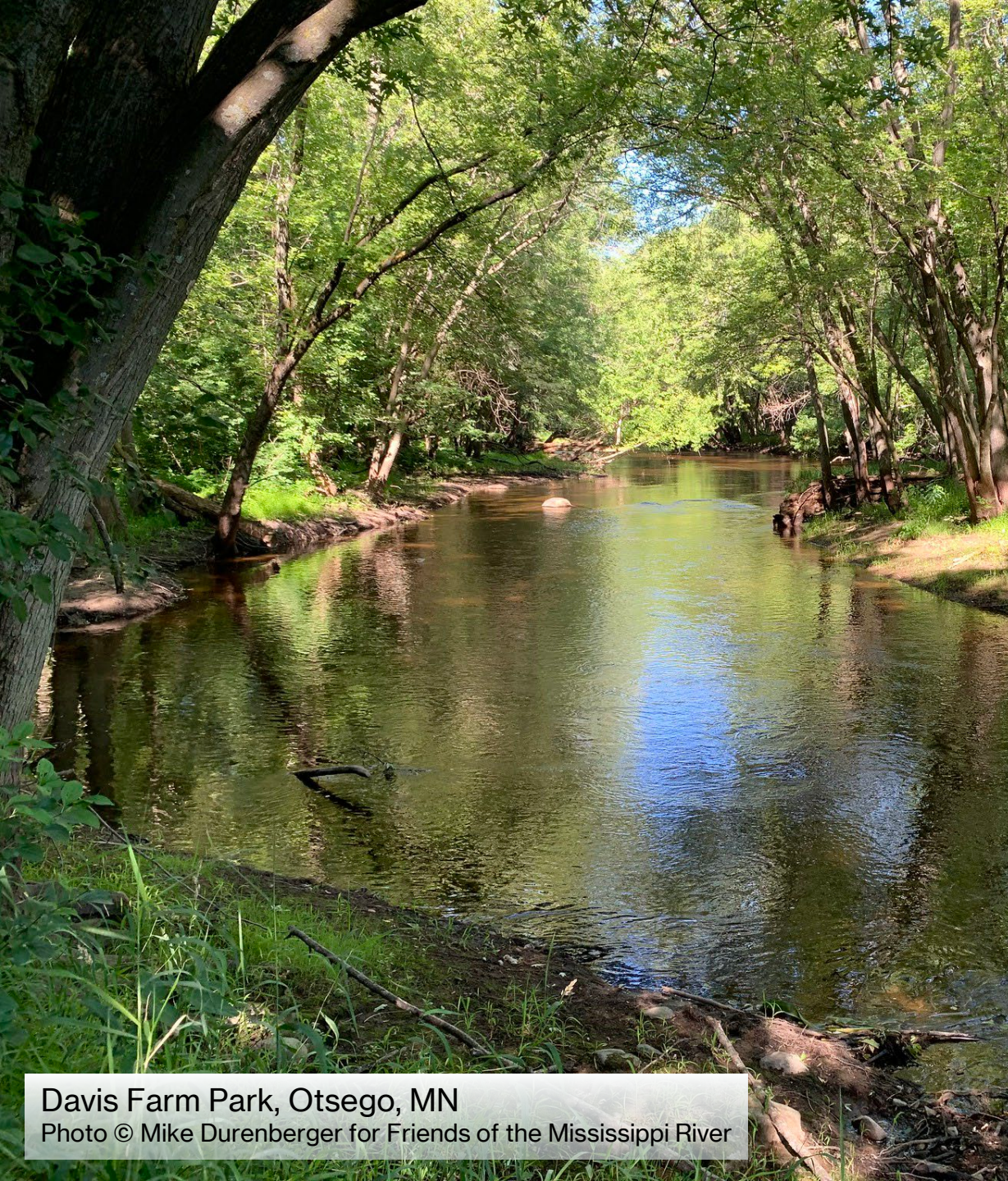
- The LSOHC website hosts a list of organizations that have received OHF dollars.
 - This list required updating.
- LSOHC staff created a plan to revise this site to improve quantity and quality of publicly accessible information.
- Strategic Communication Plan for the OHF (2011)
 - “Alignment with OHF mission”
 - Prioritize sources describing OHF restoration, protection, and enhancement of wildlife habitat
 - “Establish a Body of Accurate, Vetted Information”
 - Index all funded partners, list achievements of OHF programs
 - “Voter Right to Know”
 - Information-Centric
 - Non-Partisan

Process

- Developed digital format
 - List of funded partner organizations with logos
 - For partners with OHF-related web content, indexed relevant pages on an additional webpage for each organization.
- Since May 2025, LSOHC staff have:
 - Communicated with each funded partner organization
 - Secured permissions to share logo and copywritten media
 - Catalogued relevant external web content
 - Confirmed projects utilized OHF funds
